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#### WHOLE SCHOOL NOTICES

#### 1. Uniform Reminder:

Listed below are the 6 Uniform Non-Negotiables:

- 1. Blazers must be worn at all times.
- 2. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Blouses may remain loose.
- 3. Ties must be worn at all times.
- 4. Shoes must be black leather (or faux leather) school shoes.
- 5. Skirts must be closer to the knee than the waist.
- 6. Jewellery one gold/silver stud in each earlobe. No other jewellery.

If there is any reason why a student cannot wear the correct school uniform, then they should bring a letter or an email from home explaining why and for how long the situation is expected to last. A uniform card will be issued by the relevant Head of Year to any student who is not in full uniform for an "acceptable" reason. The card can then be shown to any member of staff who questions the deficiency.

## 2. Mobile Phone Policy Reminder

As mentioned in our email last week, we've seen an increase in students receiving calls or messages from parents during the school day, which can disrupt lessons and other activities. To help us ensure that learning stays the priority, please keep the following in mind:

Contacting students: If you need to reach your child urgently, please call the school office, and we'll make sure your message gets to them.

Student use: Students shouldn't use their phones to contact parents during the day unless they've been given permission by a staff member.

This policy helps us create a consistent, distraction-free environment for all students. Thank you for your understanding and support—it makes a real difference in maintaining a positive atmosphere in school.
